The release version will read 2025/3 on the *District Selection and Operator Menu* screen.

### Important Information

#### Traffic/Criminal – School Bus Stop Arm Camera-Based Violations – 2024 Public Act 161, 162, and 163 - Effective April 2, 2025

- This is a follow-up to the [Memorandum and FAQ](#) sent by State Court Administrator Thomas P. Boyd on March 31, 2025.
- JIS, in consultation with the State Court Administrative Office, has determined additional cash codes and charge codes are necessary due to requirements in the law.
  - Further information regarding the distribution of fines, court costs, plaintiff costs and other assessments can be found in the [District Court Fee and Assessments Table3 May2025rev1](#).
- Courts will need to update their Cash Subsystem by adding new cash codes if this type of camera-based violation is filed in the court. Further instructions are found in the [Cash section](#) below within descriptive **Cash Subsystem – Court Action Needed** headers.
  - **We suggest adding any cash code outside of regular business hours, allowing the cash code file to realign properly.**
- JIS will be adding the codes to all courts in the Traffic/Criminal Code File. The codes will be in place by the date noted at the top of this update with an **Effective Begin Date 040225**. This is what will write to the ROA when the cash codes are assessed, paid, or adjusted.
  - **CAMB: SCHOOL BUS STOP-ARM CAMERA FINE**
  - **PCOV: PLAINTIFF COST ORDINANCE CIVIL INFRACTION**
  - **PCSV: PLAINTIFF COST STATUTE CIVIL INFRACTION**
- If the camera-based offense is filed, the court will require at least one, and possibly two, new charge codes to be added to the Statute File, which will use

the new cash codes: one for a local ordinance violation (Case Type OI) and one for a statute violation (Case Type SI). See [Traffic/Criminal Statute File – Court Action Needed](#) below.

- **REMINDER:** Law enforcement has up to 30 days to mail a ticket to the defendant after receiving information regarding the offense. When entering the case on the *Traffic/Criminal Case Entry* screen, clerks will need to manually populate the **Court Date** field with a future date, accounting for this delay, to prevent the system from automatically setting the **Court Date**.
- If the camera-based offense is filed, additional 4-character codes will need to be created by the court to identify the originating school districts. This will provide a means to determine where funds should be distributed (which school district) by the county treasurer or the county treasurer’s designee. - Courts will need to set up a new cash code **CAMB** in the *Cash Subsystem* if school bus camera-based violations are filed with the court.
- JIS is adding the code **CAMB** to the Traffic/Criminal Code File when the update is installed.
  - On the *Cash Subsystem* screen, select **3. Code Files Update**, then **Cash Codes**, to display a blank *Cash Codes Update* screen.

  - On the *Traffic/Criminal Subsystem* screen, select **3. Code Files Update**, then **Statute File**, to display a blank *Statute File Inquiry & Update* screen.

**Traffic/Criminal Code File – Court Action Needed – Add Code Identifying a School District**

- A four-digit code identifier will be necessary to track school districts.
- The code should be entered on the Scheduling, Action, or Disposition screens after the case is entered.
- The school code along with the new fine code CAMB can be used for creating a Cash Report Generator. This will identify cases and the payment amount during the time frame chosen for a specific school district.
- The report can be used to supplement information found on the Local Transmittal, providing school district names and amounts collected by the courts and helping with disbursement of funds back to the school districts.
- Below is an example **Cash Report Generator**, which should meet the needs of most courts. Modify as needed.
- On the *Cash Subsystem* screen, select **5. Report Generator**, then **Enter Option = 1** on the **CASH REPORT GENERATOR MENU** to display a blank *CASH REPORT GENERATION SELECTION* screen.
